1. Introduction

Welcome to Healthsocial’s (“Company”, “we”, “our”, “us”) Healthsocial!

This Privacy Policy (“Privacy Policy,” “Policy”) govern your use of our website located at Healthsocialatlas.com (together or individually “Service”) operated by Healthsocial. Healthsocial is a business-to-business company.

Healthsocial respects the privacy rights of our online visitors and recognizes the importance of safeguarding the information we collected from you. Our Privacy Policy explains how we collect, share, safeguard, and disclose information that results from your use of our web pages, and governs your use of our Service.

Your agreement with us includes this Privacy Policy. You acknowledge that you have read and understood Agreements, and agree to be bound of them.

If you do not agree with (or cannot comply with) Agreements, then you may not use the Service, but please let us know by emailing at support@Healthsocial.com so we can try to find a solution. This Policy applies to all visitors, users, employees, applicants, and others (collectively “users”, “you”, or “your”) who wish to access or use Service.

2. Healthsocial Privacy Policy

A. Our Use and Collection of Information

We collect data from you when you use our website (“Site”) and when you engage or use our Service. Specifically, we may collect the following categories of information from you depending on how you use our Site or Service:

- **Contact Information:** We may collect contact information from you, including name, email address, job title, and company information, when you contact us or sign up to use our Service.
- **Automatically Collected Information:** We collect certain general information about your online activity automatically when you use the Site, including cookies, IP address, the date and time you access the Service, the Internet address of the website from which you linked directly to the Service, and the sections of our Site you visited.
- **Information Collected from Third Parties:** To provide our Service, we may collect information about you from third-party partners. This information may include your name, online identifiers and user names, demographic data, and data about medical conditions. Note that those third parties have privacy policies that may differ from this Privacy Policy, and we do not control the data privacy or protection policies of our third-party partners.

We use the information we collect from you to facilitate your use of the Service, provide and maintain our Site, respond to your requests, resolve problems, and maintain your account. We may also use your information to improve and understand the effectiveness of our

Service, create new services, and market our products or Service. We may also aggregate and use the information we collect about you to improve our Service

To the extent you submit billing information to us, we will only use that information to authenticate and process transactions for our Service.

B. How We Share and Disclose the Information We Collect

We do not sell or rent to others any personal information that you provide to us, except with your consent or at the direction of our partners and consistent with the terms of our contracts. We may engage third parties to perform services for Healthsocial in connection with the operation of our business and the provision of our Service.

We may also share or disclose the information we collect from you, including Personal Information, when necessary to comply with the law, including to respond to a judicial or administrative request, to respond to a subpoena, to investigate suspected fraud, harassment, physical threats, or other violations of any state, federal, or other law, rule, or regulation, to protect and enforce the rights, property, or safety of our Service, our agents, or others. We may also share the information we collect from you in the case of an emergency, including to protect the safety of our employees or users. As used in this Privacy Policy, Personal Information means information that (either alone or in combination with other information we possess) may be readily used to identify, contact, or locate you.

Additionally, as our business continues to grow and develop, we may acquire or sell a business or some of our assets. We reserve the rights to transfer the information we collect from you in connection with a sale of our business or some or all of our assets, a merger, divestiture, restructuring, dissolution, or any other change in corporate control. In the event that Healthsocial or substantially all of its assets are acquired, user information and other data may be one of the transferred assets.

C. Cookies

Similarly to other websites, our Site uses cookies to improve our Service and your online experience. “Cookies” are small data files that are placed on your computer or mobile device by your web browser, which store information about website visits and can recognize you and your preferences each time you visit the Site. Most browsers accept cookies automatically but allow you to disable them. We recommend that you allow cookies to remain “turned on” so that we can offer you a better experience on our Site; however, you may opt-out of cookies by modifying the settings in your browser or on your device.

D. Minors

The Service is intended only for access and use by individuals at least eighteen (18) years old. By accessing or using Service, you warrant and represent that you are at least eighteen (18) years of age and with the full authority, right, and capacity to enter into this agreement and abide by all of the terms and conditions of the Privacy Policy. If you are not at least eighteen (18) years old, you are prohibited from both the access and usage of Service. We do not knowingly collect

personal information from children under eighteen (18); if you are under the age of eighteen (18), please do not submit any information to the Site or Service. If you have reason to believe that a child under the age of eighteen (18) has provided their Personal Information to Healthsocial, please contact us using the contact information below and we will delete that information from our databases.

Healthsocial takes commercially reasonable safeguards to help protect your privacy and the information we collect from you. Although we implement these measures, across our Service and Site, please note that it is not possible to guarantee the security of information transmitted over the Internet. Accordingly, we cannot and do not warrant the security or integrity of any information you transmit to us when registering for our using our Service or Site.
